This bike comes with a racing pedigree–it helped Geoff Pendrell of Devinci's Daredevil racing team win the 2004 Canada Cup overall and put him on numerous podiums in 2005 and 2006. Most recently, the bike helped Adrienne Miller win the 2006 Canada Cup overall. It has unparalleled lateral rigidity, incredible manoeuvrability, and an Optimum X frame that is one of the lightest in the industry. Lower, longer, and slacker than the Ollie platform, the Wilson is designed for high-speed stability on downhill courses, and its 210mm of active rear suspension travel allows the frame and rider to withstand anything thrown at them. Years of knowledge and real-world testing have put this frame in a class of its own.
